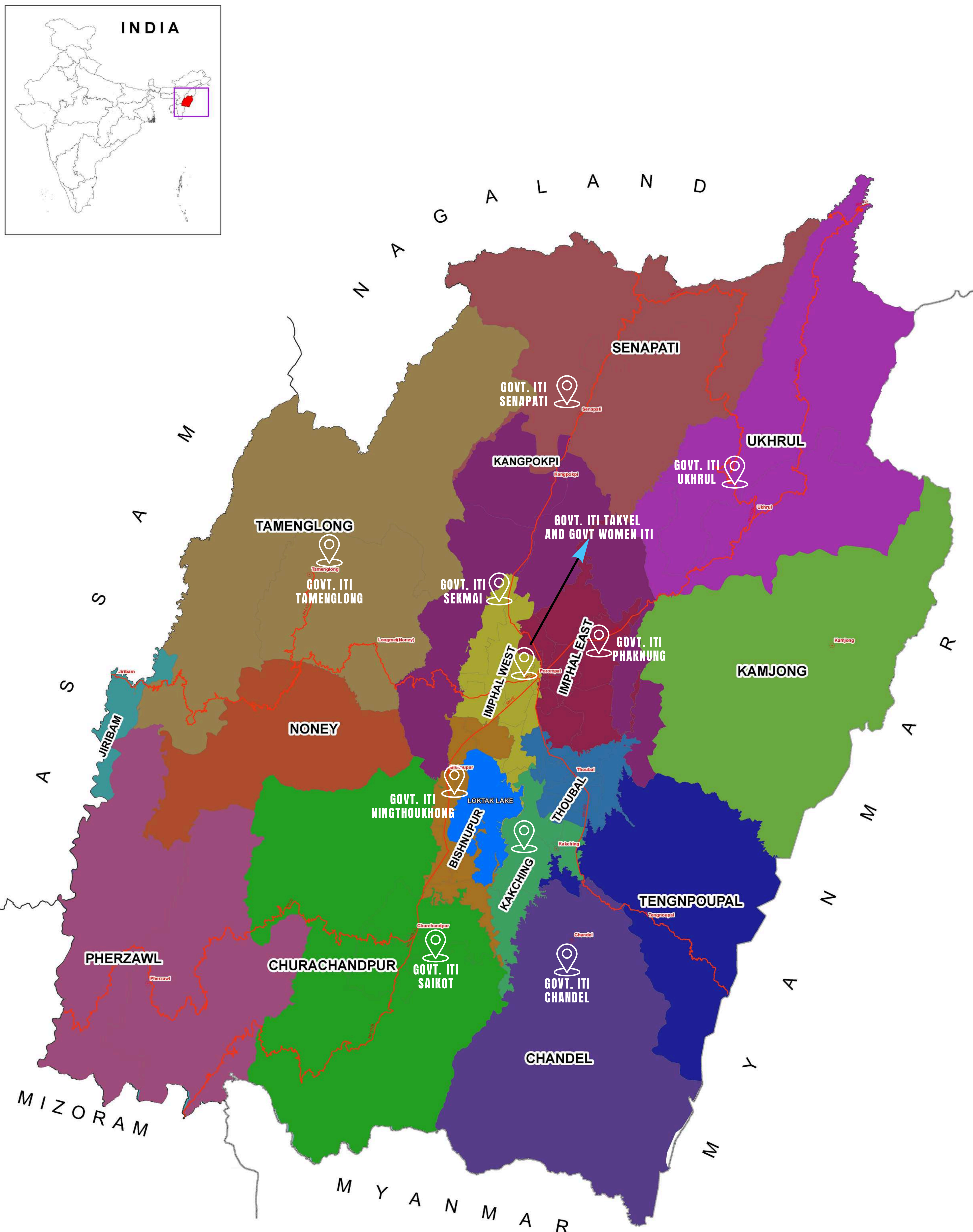
ABOUT THE DIRECTORATE OF CRAFTSMEN TRAINING MANIPUR

The Directorate of Craftsmen Training (DCT), Manipur, established in 1980, functions under the Department of Skills, Labour, Employment and Entrepreneurship, Government of Manipur (formerly the Department of Labour and Employment). It is the state level apex organization under the Administrative control of the Secretary (Lab)/Ex-Officio Director of Craftsmen Training and the Joint Director of Craftsmen Training as the head of Department for development and co-ordination of programmes relating to Vocational Training through the Industrial Training Institutes spread across the state of Manipur. Admission, training and examination (trade testing) of Craftsmen are conducted with guidance, policy and instruction from the Directorate General of Training (DGT), Govt. of India.

(i) CRAFTSMEN TRAINING SCHEME AND (ii) APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING SCHEME

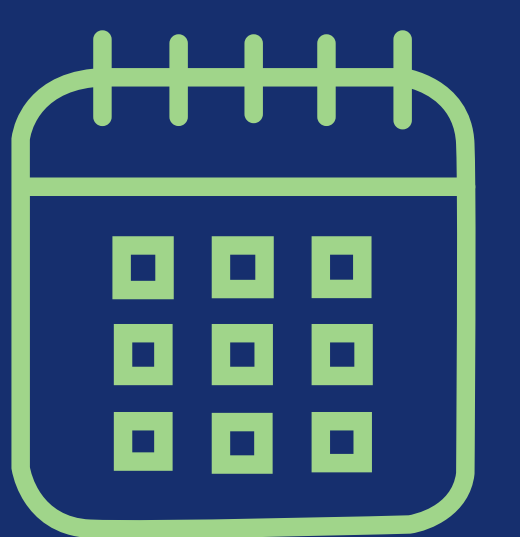
There are eleven Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) located at Takyel, Government Women ITI Takyel, Phanung, Saikot, Ukhrul, Chandel, Senapati, Tamenglong, Ningthoukhong, Kakching, and Sekmai, which play an important role in producing skilled manpower for the industrial development of the state. Additionally, the Government ITIs at Jiribam, Lilong, and Kangpokpi are currently non-operational. Two more Government ITIs are under construction under the ESDI scheme at Pherzawl and Noney.

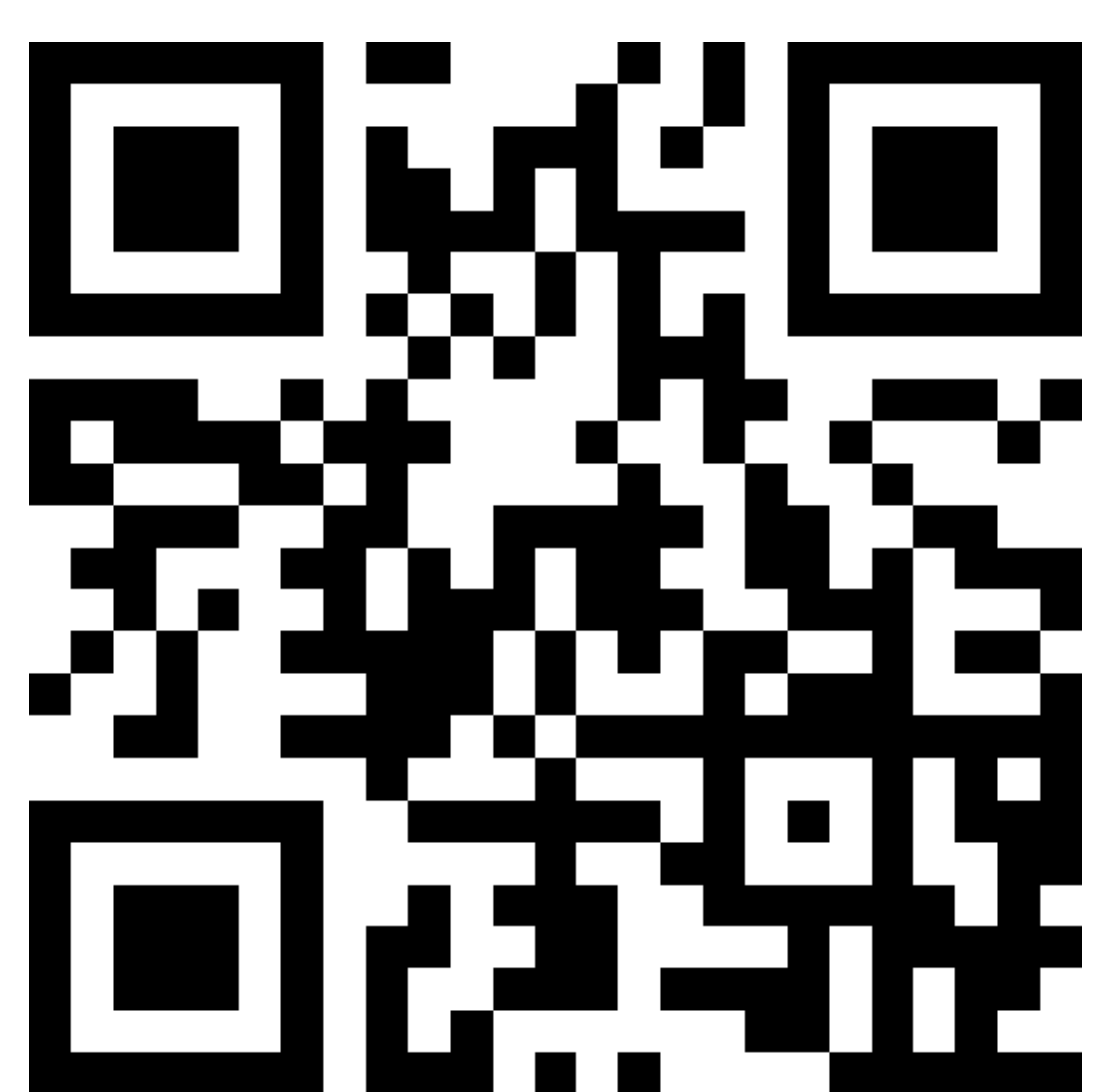

FINANCIAL BENEFITS AND INCENTIVES FOR ITI STUDENTS

The Government of Manipur, through various departments, provides financial assistance to students undergoing training in Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs). These benefits are aimed at supporting economically weaker sections and encouraging skill development among youth from diverse communities. The assistance is provided in the form of monthly stipends and scholarships under different government schemes. Below are the key schemes available to eligible ITI trainees:

1 Stipend for ITI Trainees

Provided by: Directorate of Craftsmen Training, Government of Manipur

Scheme: Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS)

- Trainees enrolled under the Craftsmen Training Scheme are eligible for monthly stipends.
- As per the norms of the Directorate General of Training (DGT), stipends are to be disbursed within three months after the Aptitude Tests conducted for newly admitted trainees.

2 Scholarship for ST ITI Trainees

Provided by: Department of Tribal Affairs and Hills, Government of Manipur

Scheme: Post-Matric Scholarship for Scheduled Tribe (ST) Students

Application Mode: Online via National Scholarship Portal (NSP) <https://scholarships.gov.in>

- This scholarship is specifically for trainees belonging to the Scheduled Tribe (ST) community.
- It is provided annually to support the educational expenses of eligible students.

3 Scholarship for SC/OBC ITI Trainees

Provided by: Department of MOBC (Minorities & Other Backward Classes), Government of Manipur

Scheme: Pre-Matric, Post-Matric, and Merit-cum-Means (MCM) Based Scholarship Schemes for Students Belonging to Minority Communities

- Annual scholarships are provided to ITI trainees from Scheduled Caste (SC) and Other Backward Class (OBC) communities to ease financial burdens and promote education.



TRAINING, COUNSELLING AND PLACEMENT CELL OF THE DCT MANIPUR

Empowering Trainees through Employment and Industry Linkages

The Training, Counselling and Placement Cell (TCPC) functions under the supervision of the Joint Director of Craftsmen Training. The Cell conducts various training programmes aimed at skilling, reskilling, and upskilling trainees, faculty members, and staff under the Directorate, thereby enhancing technical competence and promoting continuous professional development.

In addition, the TCPC provides career counselling and guidance to trainees from time to time, enabling them to make informed career choices and improve their employability. The Cell also plays an active role in strengthening industry linkages by collaborating with industries, employers, and other stakeholders to ensure alignment between training outcomes and evolving industry requirements.

The TCPC organizes campus placement drives, usually held at Government ITI, Takyel, Imphal, for trainees from all Government ITIs in the State. These placement activities are conducted in close coordination with industries and recruiting organizations to facilitate employment opportunities for skilled trainees.

INDUSTRY COLLABORATION AND MOU'S

The Directorate signs Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with reputed industries and organizations to further strengthen skilling, reskilling, and upskilling initiatives, coordinated through the Training and Placement Cell.

The Directorate conducts placement-related activities in collaboration with organizations such as the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), Model Career Centre (MCC), Guwahati, National Skill Training Institute (NSTI), Imphal Extension, National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), Wadhvani Foundation, Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), Eastern Motors (Maruti Suzuki Arena), MGT Tata Motors, Tata Electronics, Foxconn, Motherson Sumi Systems Limited, Tata STRIVE, TAFE, Bharti Airtel, Somemiya Corporation Pvt. Ltd., JCNT Elevator, Wistron, Blinkit, Indus Towers, GE HealthCare, Qness Corp Ltd., among others.

These collaborations help strengthen industry-institute linkage and ensure that trainees are trained in alignment with current industry requirements.

OUTREACH AND AWARENESS ACTIVITIES

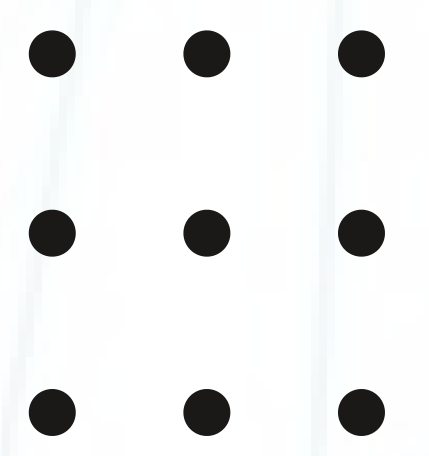
The Directorate conducts various outreach and awareness programmes to promote Industrial Training Institute (ITI) education and highlight its importance in building skilled and employable youth.

Awareness programmes on the benefits of ITI training are organized to encourage students to opt for skill-based career pathways. The Directorate also undertakes sensitization programmes on industry expectations, employability skills, and career progression pathways for trainees and prospective students. Through these activities, the Directorate aims to strengthen awareness of vocational education and support informed career choices among students and trainees.

MEGA JOB FAIRS

The Directorate organizes Mega Job Fairs in collaboration with industry partners and stakeholders to provide large-scale employment opportunities for ITI trainees and skilled youth across the State. These events serve as a major platform for direct interaction between employers and job seekers, enabling immediate recruitment opportunities across various sectors.



PLACEMENT DATA (2024 TO TILL DATE)

The placement figures below are indicative and are based on campus recruitment and placement drives conducted at Government ITI Takyel, where ITI trainees from across the state participated. In addition to these campus placements, many trainees have secured employment in various organizations, including positions outside their core ITI trades. 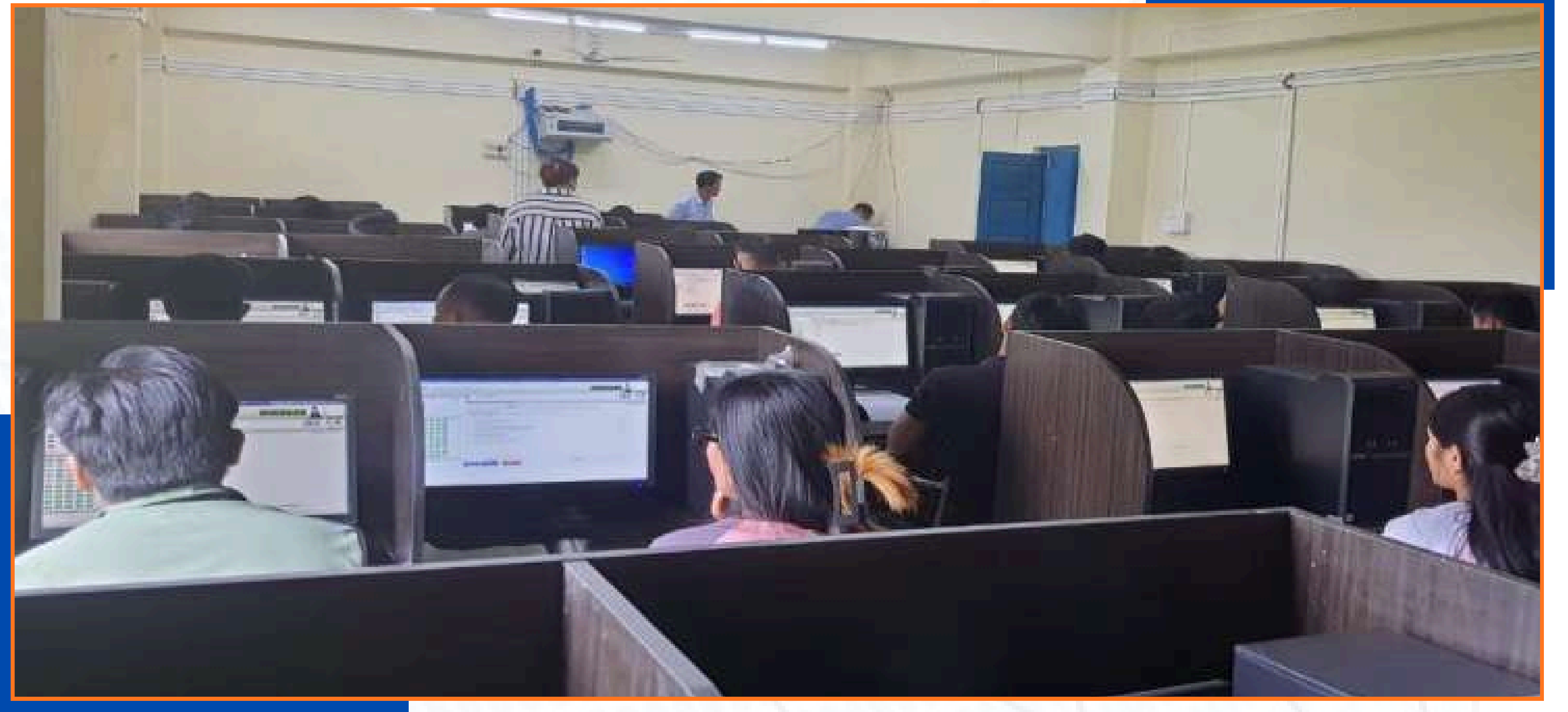


STATE-OF-THE-ART LAB & WORKSHOP FACILITIES
